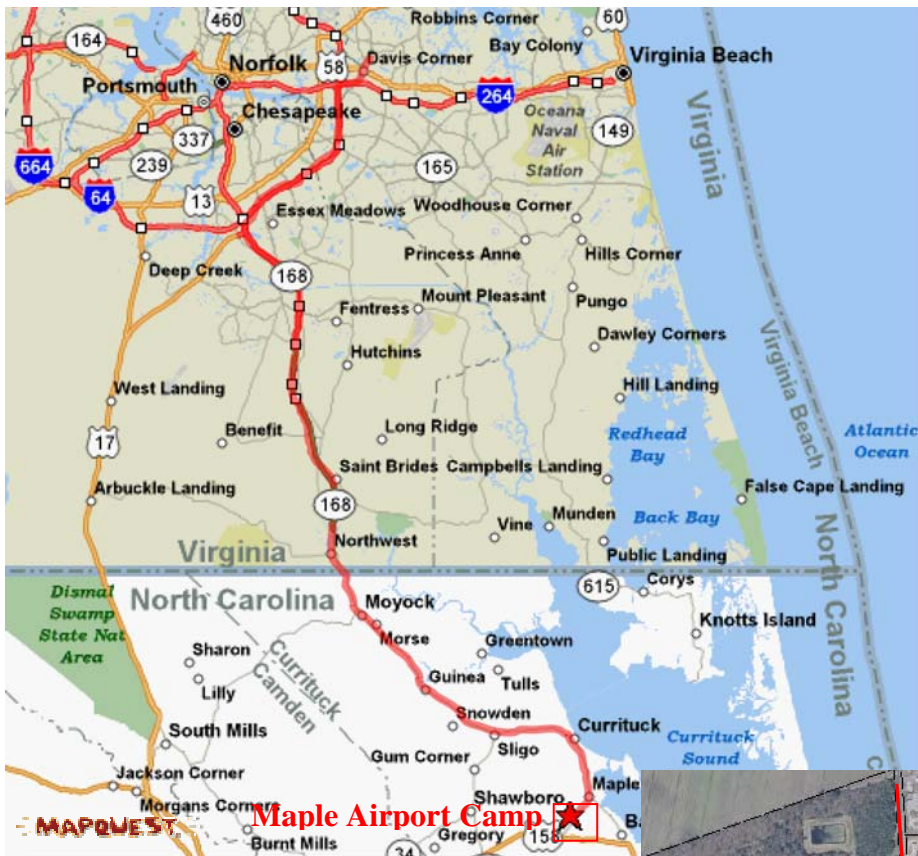




# Maple Airport Camp

Maple Airport Camp is the newest of Tidewater Council's short term camps. Leased from Currituck County, North Carolina, the camp is adjacent to Maple Park and the Currituck County Regional Airport property. A surprise to the first time visitor, the camp is connected to Maple Park via a network of nature, hiking and horse trails. At the park a variety of activities are available including a baseball/softball field, volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, fitness trail and a fishing lake. Camp facilities include a large activity field, numerous camp sites

equipped with picnic tables, fire rings and portable restrooms. Campers will need to provide their own drinking water. For reservations or information, call Pam Vickery at Tidewater Council (757) 497-2688.



Directions: ■ From the Tidewater Area take VA-168 S toward Nags Head, approx 32 miles from I-64 turn right onto Maple Rd. Continue 2.3 miles to Shortcut Rd and turn left. Traveling 0.2 miles, turn left again onto Airport Road. After 0.8 miles, turn right at the Currituck Regional County Airport terminal. The paved road continues 0.3 miles behind the airport terminal building and then changes to a dirt road. Camp is located 0.7 miles from the end of the paved road.
