### 2010 – WHAT'S NEW & DIFFERENT

#### Huskanaw

1. Changed from a 2 hour program to a 3 hour program. The extra hour will be used to introduce new campers to the different parts of Camp Lions for recreational activities that do not require accountability for any learning material (for example, free archery shoot, free climbing on the tower, free canoe/rowing, time at the archaeology dig, etc.).

#### Finish First

1. We will not schedule this informal program session for those needing only a few requirements for rank advancement. This can be pre-arranged with the Huskanaw Director. The logic behind this is that those youth should have the opportunity to do something fun in a coordinated program session and not wait their turn for a counselor to work with them in a un-coordinated program.

#### Merit Badge Menu

2. Fishing - added
3. Hiking – removed
4. Canoeing – moved to river
5. Rowing – moved to river

#### Merit Badge Schedule

1. The whole schedule has changed to minimize the amount of set-up for counselors. For example, alternating between Woodworking & Leatherwork requires different materials & equipment therefore several of the same sessions will now be back to back. This also keeps the counselor more organized.
2. Added 6<sup>th</sup> program session to allow more campers to take high demand merit badges.
3. Allows more opportunities for “Double Session” programs like Environmental Science.
4. Inserts “Open Programs” into the schedule (for example, rifle, archery, sailing, canoeing, etc.)
