HUSKANAW PROGRAM

Huskanaw is the Powhatan Indian name for the rite of passage that taught young men the skills needed to meet their responsibilities in the tribe. Our Huskanaw Challenge does much the same thing by teaching new Scouts the skills they need to fully participate in troop activities. Scouts spend two hours each morning or afternoon learning advancement skills for Tenderfoot through First Class. During the remainder of the day, they can participate in up to three merit badge sessions.

OTHER HIGHLIGHTS

- More than 40 merit badges are offered, including 8 required for Eagle Scout.
- Opportunities for unit conservation projects.
- Many unique science merit badges including Nuclear Science, which includes a tour of Dominion Virginia Power's Surry Nuclear Power Plant.
