Make sure you have the following documents before arriving at camp:

- Certification and claim forms for Troop Medical Insurance-out of council only.
- All fees are paid; please bring your records just in case.
- Only Out of Council units must have a valid Tour Permit and Certificate of Insurance.
- Two Troop Rosters of Scouts and Leaders (one for registration, one for your records).
- Transportation Sheet.
- Travel-Do not travel in a caravan; all drivers must have a map to camp; all parties must wear a seat belt.
- All Scouts are registered (Check those new Webelos).
- Each youth and adult has:
 1. The appropriate medical form, signed by a physician and guardian.
 2. a copy of the Family Insurance Card attached to the medical form.
 3. If taking medications, the Scout's parents have followed the procedures in the Leaders Guide.

Early Arrivals:

Units traveling long distances or those religious groups sometimes need to arrive on Saturday night. If we know that you are coming, we will have an adult meet with your group and show you to your campsite for the evening. Showers are available for your use. However, as few staff are in camp, the lake, pool and waterfront are off-limits and all program areas including the dining hall are closed. We will check your group in on Sunday after 1:15 p.m.
