

Camp Lions Honor Troop Award

The Camp Lions Honor Troop Award is designed to strengthen your troop by encouraging a strong commitment to the ideals of Scouting and building team spirit. It is not a competition among troops, but a challenge to each individual unit. Any troop that meets all the criteria will receive the award (there may be more than one Honor Troop per week). Scoring and evaluation will be done by the camp Commissioner, with input from the Chaplain, Camp Directors, and others. The Award consists of a certificate and a special streamer for the troop flag; presentation will be made at the closing campfire. Criteria are as follows:

CAMPING SKILLS: Maintain an average score of at least 90% on campsite inspections, or show continuous improvement with a final score of at least 90%.

SCOUT SPIRIT: Show enthusiasm as a unit at campwide events. Bring troop flag or other identifying banner to pre-meal assemblies.

UNIFORM: At least 80% of troop members (youth and adult) attend evening events and campfires in properly-worn prescribed uniform.

SERVICE: Clean central showers or pool showers at least once.

LEADERSHIP: At least one adult leader earns Mamanatowick's Mantle.

TROOP ACTIVITY: At least half the troop participates in at least one afternoon or evening activity as a group.

DUTY TO GOD: At least 80% of the troop attends a worship service at camp and/or a member participates in Chaplain's Aid training.

PATROL METHOD: All patrols have and display patrol flags in camp. At least one patrol earns the Pipsico Patrol Award.
